WOMEN'S HEALTH UPDATE

The Women's Health Hub in North Liverpool PCN provides a range of services to patients within network. The hub aims to improve access to women's services in our local area. Services include insertion removal of Long-Acting Reversible Contraception (coils and implants), with coils offered for all (contraception, indications periods, and as part of Hormone Replacement Therapy). This service predominantly from operates Croxteth Family Health Clinic (L11 0BS).

Access to the Women's Health Hub services is available via your GP surgery—reception can refer you directly, or you can ask a healthcare professional to book you a telephone triage appointment. ANNUAL PATIENT REVIEWS: BOOK YOUR APPOINTMENT

Having a single annual review is the quickest and most convenient way of monitoring long-term conditions. Without regular check-ups, conditions can worsen, and complications might arise that damage your health.

If you have one of the following conditions, then often you are required to attend the Surgery for an annual health check:

- Diabetes
- Impaired Glucose
- Heart Failure
- Stroke
- Hypertension (high blood pressure)
- Atrial fibrillation
- · · Coronary Heart Disease
- · · Asthma
- Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease (COPD)
- Long term mental health problems
- Learning Disabilities
- Dementia

From April 2025 – we have been inviting in a new system where your annual reviews and/or blood test monitoring to coincide with your BIRTHDAY month.

You will be contacted by the Practice either via text message or letter when your annual health check is due. A blood test may be required depending on your condition. Please call reception between 10-6.30pm to book your appointment.
